THE GOAL AND THE OBJECTIVES of the project are:

- a) to create a complete circuit of vocational initiation, starting with the initial stage and ending with the guidance provided for persons with disabilities;
- b) to correlate the vocational training for persons with disabilities with the human resources demands on the labour market;
- c) to ensure the efficient communication between the vocational training organizations for persons with disabilities and reduced work capacity;
- d) to initiate the adaptation of people with disabilities and of SMEs to the new concept of sustainable development;
- e) to elaborate a common system of education and vocational training for persons with disabilities; to provide disabled persons with lifelong unlimited access to this system;
- f) to create a system of links among the training organizations on the one hand and the governmental or non-governmental organizations on the other, in order to make the actions public and to disseminate the results. In this way, we expect to sensitize people of all ages about the issue of disabled persons.
